First Things First

As soon as you move in . . .

- 1 Complete your Room Inventory Condition Form**
 An electronic version of the Room Inventory Condition Form will be available after move-in. The purpose of this form is to create a record of any damages in your bedroom and common area prior to your move-in. This will eliminate any charges to your account for damages that you did not cause when you vacate your home in the future. The Room Inventory Condition Form will need to be completed within 24 hours of receiving your keys. In the event there is an urgent request, please notify the office staff and a service request will be created to get these items resolved as quickly as possible. Service requests can be made anytime via the portal.

- 2 Set up your Mailbox at the University Center with Mail Services | 361.825.2684**
 Mail Services processes all incoming mail for Camden Miramar residents and provides services and supplies needed for outgoing mail, including UPS shipping services. Student mail and packages are received daily at the UC mail center and are available by 1 pm Monday-Friday. Mailboxes are accessible during UC building hours. Students will be notified by email if they have an item requiring a signature and must present their SandDollar\$ card for pick up.

Please note that your mailbox assignment will not be the same as your room assignment. Boxes will be issued and remain the same for the duration of on-campus living. Your mailbox number will not change if you change rooms. Additionally, there are three outgoing drop locations for stamped mail located at the UC mail center, the NRC building and behind the Bell Library.

Sign Up: Students will be notified by email the week of move-in with instructions on how and when to sign up for their mailbox.

Notes

Patios, Balconies and Windows

To keep the overall appearance of the property attractive, nothing but blinds should be visible from the windows. Residents shall not hang, display or expose to public view any items inconsistent with the decor and atmosphere of the community. All furniture provided with the unit should remain indoors at all times.

Storage of Bicycles and Motorcycles

Because of the possibility of fire, at no time may motorcycles, scooters or mopeds be stored in residence halls. Any internal combustion engine vehicle discovered in a residence hall room will be removed and stored at the owner's expense. Bicycles stored outside must be in appropriate bicycle racks. Any bicycle that is not attached to an appropriate rack is subject to removal.

Laundry Facilities

Laundry facilities for the apartments are located in buildings 1, 2 and 7. Each Residence Hall floor has designated equipment.

Cable and Internet

Each resident is provided with a standard data jack for 24-hour Internet access. Residents are allowed to use their own personal router to receive Wi-Fi within their unit, but for the most reliable connection, devices should be directly plugged into the wall using an Ethernet cable. If using Wi-Fi, it is recommended that residents password protect their access.

Smoking

There is no smoking permitted within 25 feet of any entrance to a building.

Quiet and Courtesy Hours

Quiet hours of 11:00 pm – 9:00 am for weekdays (Sunday through Thursday evening) and 1:00 am – 9:00 am for weekends (Friday and Saturday evenings) are enforced and monitored in order to ensure the community's ability to sleep and study. Musical equipment or devices are not to be played in such a manner as to disturb other residents.

Overnight Guest Policy

Residents may have a maximum of two overnight guests for a maximum of two consecutive nights, not to exceed two separate occasions per month.

Alcohol

Any student who is under the legal drinking age and found in a room or vehicle with alcohol or empty alcohol containers may be cited as a Minor in Possession and/or reported to the Office of Judicial Affairs. University policy prohibits the consumption of alcoholic beverages or the possession of alcoholic beverages in public areas of the campus (including the Camden Miramar community).

Fire Hazards and Prohibited Appliances

No open flames of any type are permitted for any reason. This includes candles, kerosene lamps, oil lamps, hookahs, shishas, including any items that create ember or ashes etc. Extension cords without a surge suppressor used as permanent wiring or electrical outlets are not permitted. Halogen lamps, holiday lights, toasters, toaster ovens, space heaters and personal grills are prohibited.
